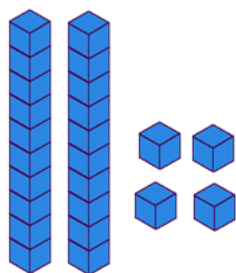


Top Tips for Home Learning – Year 1
